SportsMan SQL now allows you the ability to register a individual who is on the wait list directly from the wait list screen without taking any additional/extra steps of expanding the class. If you process the wait list registration from that screen, SportsMan will now prompt you to automatically expand the class and do the work for you.

Emailing Coaches/Instructors

Coaches/instructors are now included on the recipient list when emailing from SportsMan reports. After you run the report, select the "Send Email Message to Participants" option which will bring up the "Preview Email List" screen, from there you now have the ability to include the coaches/instructors in all email communication.
