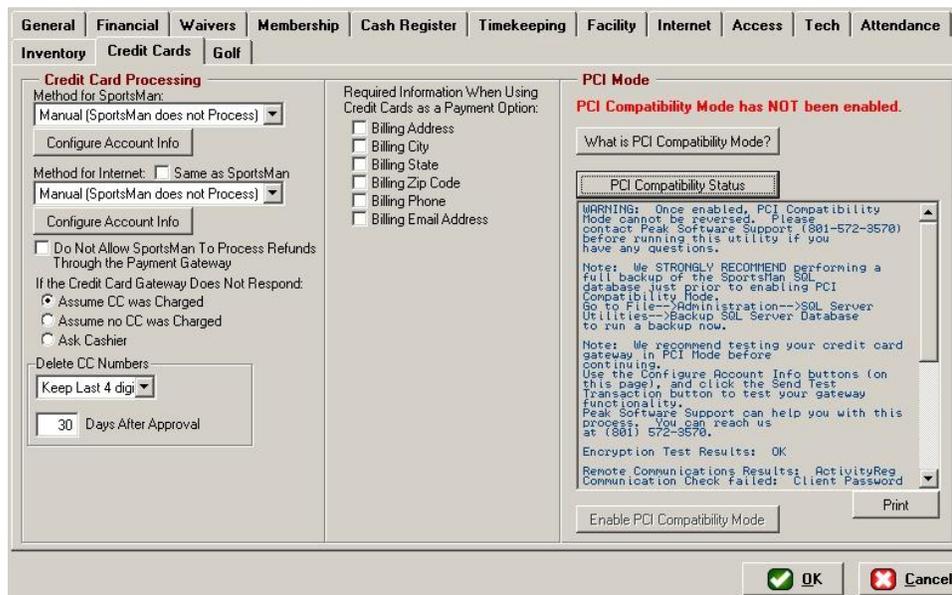


SportsMan SQL, PCI Compliance, and Credit Card Security
