

New Cash Register Design Tools

If you utilize the POS module in SportsMan, you probably have noticed the new Cash Register design layout and the associated custom Cash Register design tools. If you haven't noticed, you may need to update SportsMan (File>Administration>Application Updates>Check for Application Updates, see side article for more details).

The new Cash Register design tools give you the ability to not only customize the Cash Register buttons, as many as you would like in fact, but to completely design a Cash Register layout with custom screen sizing, images, background color and keysets.

New Cash Register Layout Example



To start creating a new Cash Register layout, go to File>Maintain Tables>Cash Register>Cash Register Key Definitions, and select the "Add" button. Now select if you want to use the new Cash Register layout or a legacy keyset. The new layout and design tools are under the option Cash Register Layout (note: you can still create the old keysets, to do so choose the option Keyset only). The next step is to select from the included Cash Register templates that you may build upon to create a unique Cash Register for your organizations POS needs. Using the Cash Register Design Tool: define size, placement, functions, and optional elements of the Cash Register layout.



SportsMan Updates

We always recommend that you keep SportsMan up to date with the new software releases. If you have not updated for a while it is a very simple process. In SportsMan SQL go to File>Administration>Application Updates>Check for Application Updates. If an update is available you may download it and the system will implement the update automatically to the server and all workstations. To automate the Check for Application Updates even more, you may define a SportsMan user to automatically have the system check for updates when the user logs into Sportsman SQL. This can be accomplished by logging into SportsMan as the System Administrator and by going to File> Administration> User Administration, edit the user, select the Security tab, and check the Application Updates box.
